The results of a survey.

In May we finalized the results from questionnaires. We carried out two surveys. We questioned one hundred students and one hundred grandparents. Here are the results:

Questionnaire for students:

- 1. The majority of young people surveyed know(or knew) their grandparents.(Only one student doesn't know them)
- 2. 70 % of grandparents are still alive.
- 3. 39% of grandparents live (or lived) in the same town. The majority (60%) lives in another town. Only one student implied that his/her grandparents live in another country.
- 4. 70 % of students visit their grandparents once a week. Only 19 % visit them every day. A small number of students visit their grandparents once a month. (11%)
- 5. For a reasonable number of students (80%) grandparents are really important. Only 20% of pupils find them less important.
- 6. Almost all of young people questioned indicated : love (88%), support (87%) and money (12%) as their expectations from the older generation.

Questionnaire for grandparents

50% of people questioned were female50% of those questioned were male.70% of grandparents were married1% of them was divorced2% of the people surveyed were widowed

- 1. The majority of older people are retired (99%)
- 2. The average age of retirement is 55.
- 3. A farmer was the most popular profession they performed.
- 4. The majority of grandparents worked for 35 years (40%), 40 years (20%), 37 years (10%), 33 years (10%), 17 years (10%), 60 years (10%)
- 5. A reasonable number of those questioned (70%) graduated from primary school. Only 30% left school at secondary education level.
- 6. All of people surveyed use government support(money).
- 7. 80% of grandparents take part in family activities, only 10% in sport activities and 30% in hobbies.
- 8. Majority of people (70%) have got free time activities eg. gardening, crochet.
- 9. Most of the grandparents expect the following from the younger generation: respect (60%), help (30%), education (20%) kindness (10%).
- 10. Changes in behavior of the growing –up generation that have been noticed by the elderly people are as follows:
 - confidence (44%)
 - aggressiveness (28%)
 - lack of manners (28%)
- 11. The pieces of advice given by the elderly to the young people are:
 - to be more optimistic (10%)
 - to have a good profession in the future (20%)
 - to have purpose in life (20%)
 - education (30%)
 - -not to take drugs and not to drink alcohol (10%)
 - -to show respect (40%)

- 12. The grandparents' dreams are:
 - to be healthy (20%)
 - -to see the Baltic Sea (10%)
 - to travel around the world (20%)
 - 50 % indicated that they don't have any dreams
- 13. The grandparents meet with people of their own age: often - 40% sometimes - 20% rarely - 20% never - 20%
- 14. When they meet with people of their own age they
 - talk -70%
 - drink coffee -50%
