

Old And Young Generations Encouraged To Communicate Through Eu Project



The privately funded Ata Primary School has become involved in the Comenius project. The theme of this project is "Young and Old Living Together". Four schools, from Turkey – Fethiye, Germany – Freidrichschafen, Latvia - Daugavpils and Poland – Czestochowa respectively, will be taking part in this project until the 31st July 2011.

The project is aimed at young and old generations sharing with each other their experiences throughout their lives to achieve a better understanding, mutual love and respect between them, which will hoped to enhance the diminishing regard for the elderly as well as encouraging



communication between the generations. Furthermore, the schools involved in the project are expected to share the results of their research and activities, profiting from the experiences of each other.

Up to now, the administrators and students of these schools got together in Germany during October, 2009, in Latvia in 2010 and more

recently in Poland. The subsequent meetings will take place in Fethiye during April, 2011, and in Germany during June, 2011.

The project constitutes a part of Lifelong Learning Programme of the National Agency within the Centre of EU Education and Youth Programmes. Ata Primary School is able to participate in the Comenius project, as a result of a 13,000 Euro donation.
